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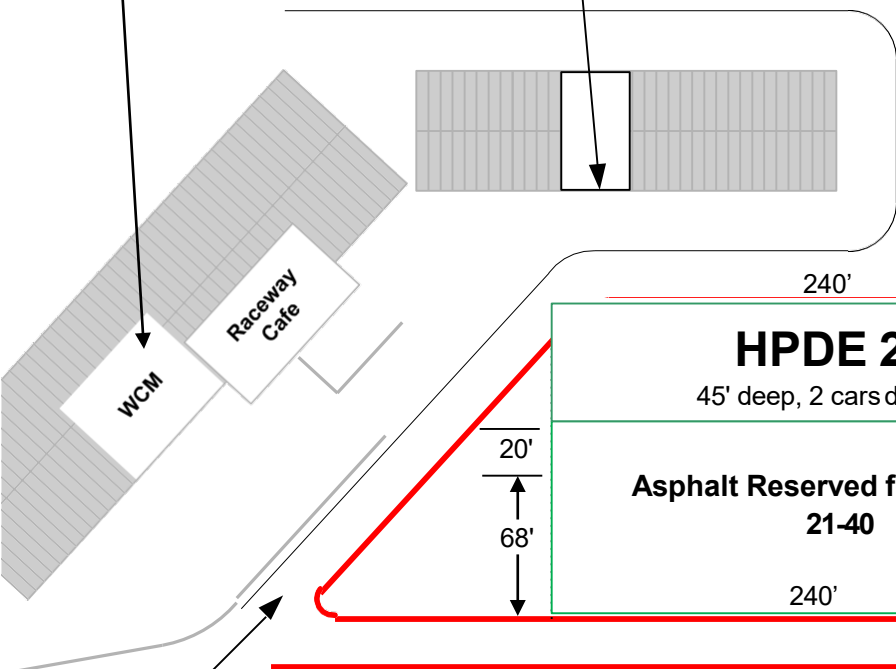

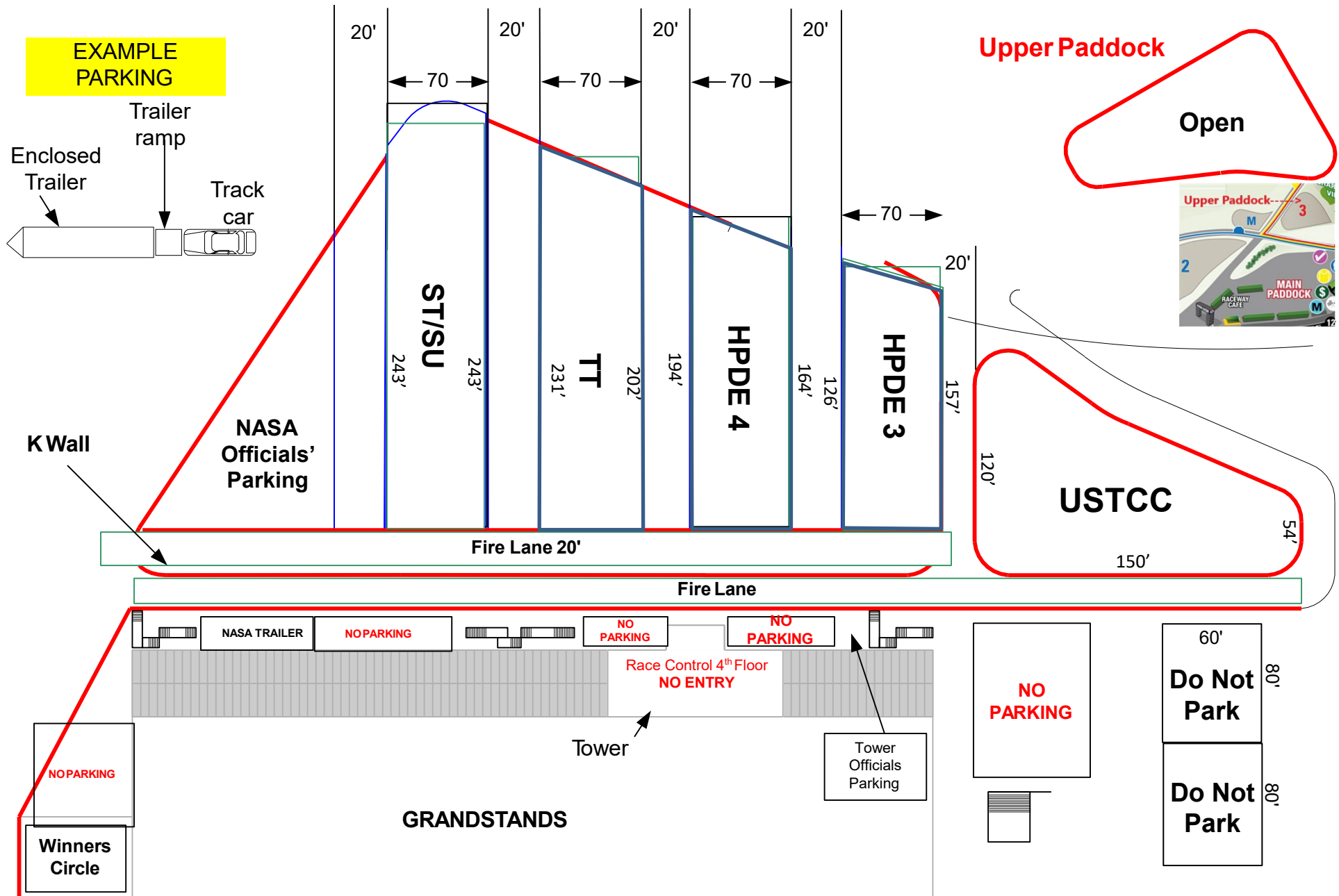


**FIRE LANE**

## RACE DIRECTOR FACT SHEET

**Series Overview:** Formula Car Challenge (FCC) & Formula Pro USA (FPUSA) are two junior formula car series based on the West Coast. The two entities work together to hold combined race events.

FCC is a multi-class series that features the Formula Mazda (FM) and Pro Formula Mazda (PFM).

FPUSA is a multi-class series that features the Formula-4 (F4) and Formula-3/Regional (F3/FR) cars.

### Regulations:

- For events with NASA, both series agree to operate under the NASA Club Codes and Regulations for on track conduct.
- Both series supply their own technical regulations and will work with NASA tech officials to coordinate any compliance needs.

Car Tech: All cars must have a current SCCA Annual Technical Inspection to compete.

Driver Licensing: All drivers must hold an SCCA Full Competition License in good standing.

### **Event Operations Details (should also be covered in the driver's meeting):**

1. The flags are of top importance, we will follow the CCR for penalties. Restart flag procedure review.
2. Podiums will be immediately following the race, drivers must be in their suit with the appropriate patches to be on the podium and receive trophies.
3. There may be a split start depending on car counts in classes.
4. One pace lap, flying start, multiple waves likely.
5. Scrubbing tires only allowed while behind a pace car that has it's lights on.
6. Initial Starts, drivers must all maintain pace-car speed until the green flag is displayed.
7. For Restarts, the leader may accelerate out of the final corner.
8. Note any differences in flaggers, or flagger positions.

### Out on Green

The first session of the event will have one lap of standing yellow, after that all sessions should be out on green.

### **SAFETY**

When in doubt go FULL COURSE YELLOW or BLACK-ALL. No "hot-tows" should be performed with cars on track (if a tow is needed during a race it should only happen after cars are controlled by the pace car).

### Pace Car

Speed – minimum sustained speed of 25mph to keep formula cars from overheating. Best case is for pace car to go as fast as is safe for conditions.

Lights – (for starts and restarts) Lights should be turned off a minimum of 2 corners prior to going green.

### QUALIFYING PARC FERME

All cars should go to impound following qualifying and race sessions.
